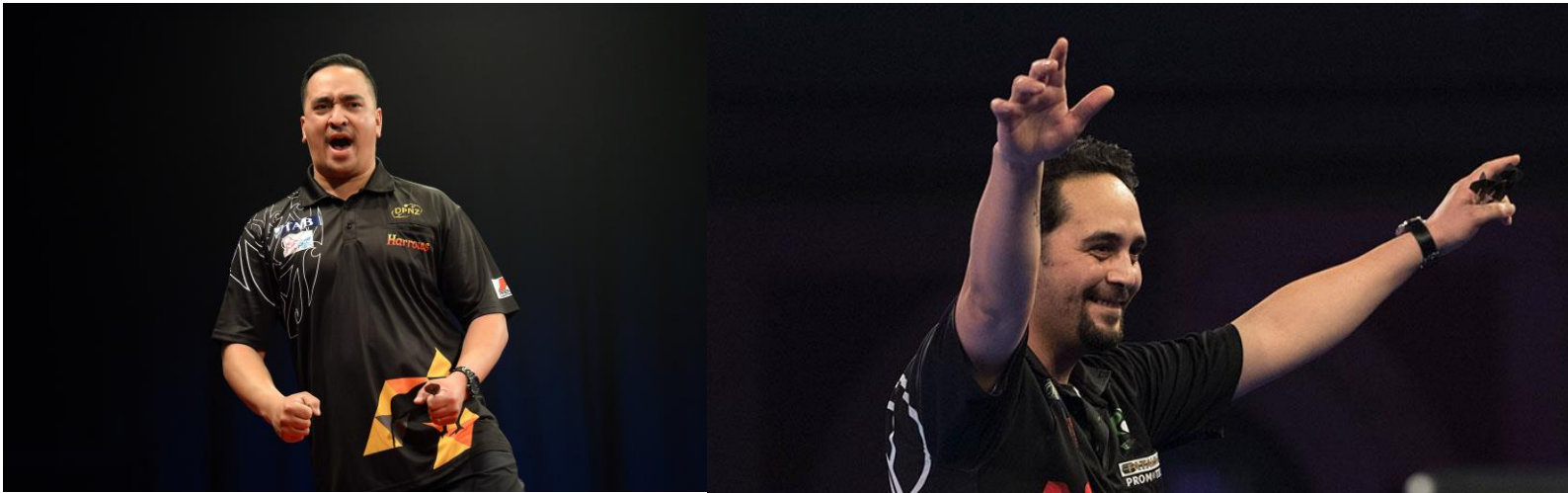


HAUPAI PUHA is to make his BetVictor World Cup of Darts Debut

HAUPAI PUHA is to make his BetVictor World Cup of Darts debut in June after being confirmed alongside Cody Harris in the New Zealand team for the PDC event.



Auckland's Harris will lead the two-player Kiwi side for the World Cup of Darts in Hamburg, Germany, from June 6-9 after establishing himself on the professional circuit in Europe.

Harris will be joined by Christchurch's Puha, who tops the Dart Players New Zealand rankings following a strong year on the domestic circuit.

Puha also made his TV debut in 2018, competing in the PDC's Auckland Darts Masters and Melbourne Darts Masters events on the World Series of Darts circuit.

Harris has greater big-stage experience, having played in the last three World Cups and twice at the World Championship, as well as most recently in March's UK Open.



The BetVictor World Cup of Darts sees 32 nations competing across four days in Hamburg, with the tournament featuring a combination of Singles and Doubles matches as they challenge for a £70,000 (NZ\$135,000) top prize.
